INDICTMENT

FOR:

COUNT 1: UNLAWFUL DISTRIBUTION OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES, 63 O.S. § 2-401(A)(1)

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Sixteenth Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from January 30, 2017, for eighteen (18) months, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Sixteenth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and woman, legally drawn and summoned according to law, and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn, and charged according to law to diligently inquire into, and true presentment make, of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable


within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find:

COUNT 1: UNLAWFUL DISTRIBUTION OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES, 63 O.S. § 2-401(A)(1)

On or between the 28th day of February, 2017, through the 18th day of April, 2017, the crime of **UNLAWFUL DISTRIBUTION OF CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCES** was committed in **POTTAWATOMIE COUNTY**, Oklahoma, by the defendants **JERI LYNN ELLIS and DENNIS LEE ROBERTS**, acting in concert with one another. On said date, and within said County and State, the defendants did willfully, intentionally, knowingly, and feloniously distribute Schedule II controlled dangerous substances outside the usual course of medical practice or without a legitimate medical purpose by Roberts preparing prescriptions for a controlled dangerous substance that Roberts was not legally authorized to issue and Ellis signing the prescription for a patient that Ellis had never physically examined or evaluated. All of the foregoing being committed in violation of Section 2-401(A) of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
