

CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT in violation of 21 O.S. § 1713.1 [Counts 1 through 10]

OBTAINING MONEY, PROPERTY OR THING OF VALUE BY FALSE PRETENSE in violation of 21 O.S. § 1541.1 & 1541.2 [Count 11]

POSSESSION OF A STOLEN OR CONVERTED VEHICLE OR IMPLEMENT OF HUSBANDRY in violation of 47 O.S. § 4-103 [Count 12]

POSSESSION OF A VEHICLE WITHOUT A VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER in violation of 47 O.S. § 1503 (C) [Count 13]

CONSPIRACY TO VIOLATE THE CRIME OF RECEIVING OR CONCEALING STOLEN FARM EQUIPMENT in violation of 21 O.S. § 421 [Count 14]

RACKETEERING in violation of 22 O.S. § 1403 [Count 15]

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the Order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Thirteenth Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from January 24, 2011 until July 24, 2012 or until the designated presiding judge determines the Thirteenth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigation, but in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) from the commencement of its term. That the said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and women, legally drawn and summons according to law and then and there examined, empanelled, sworn and charged according to the law to diligently inquire into and true presentment make of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find that:

**COUNT 1: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED
CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**

Commencing on or about the 1st day of July 2008, A.D., through the 26th day of April, 2011, A.D. in Sequoyah and Lincoln Counties, Oklahoma Phillip Hawk feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Phillip Hawk and George Baker, who conjointly, bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Lance Berglan, the owner, personal property, namely a Green Honda Four Wheeler [REDACTED] Rancher with last six digits of the VIN being [REDACTED], that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: obtaining the said Honda Four Wheeler from Lance Berglan at his residence on Jackson Mountain Rod north of Marble City, Oklahoma Said acts by Phillip Hawk and George Baker are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

**COUNT 2: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED
CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**

Commencing on or about the 3rd day of December, 2009, A.D., through the 26th day of April, 2011, A.D. in Washington and Lincoln Counties, Oklahoma Kory Pierson and George

Baker, conjointly and feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Clyde Shepard, the owner, personal property, namely a Kawasaki 600 Mule with partial serial number of the last six digits being [REDACTED], that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: Kory Pierson taking said Kawasaki Mule from Shep's Yamaha at 3601 Southeast Frank Phillips Blvd., in Bartlesville, OK and concealing it on property at or near the residence of George Baker. Said acts by Kory Pierson and George Baker are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 3: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT

Commencing on or about the 31st day of July 2012, A.D., through the 26th day April of 2011, A.D. in Sequoyah and Lincoln Counties, Oklahoma Kory Pierson and George Baker conjointly and feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Kory Pierson and George Baker bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Harold Rogers, the owner, personal property, namely a Kubota RTV 900 with serial number [REDACTED], that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to

believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: Kory Pierson taking the said Kubota RTV 900 at Highway 82 on Moonshine Road near Vain, OK and conveying it to George Baker. Said acts by Kory Pierson and George Baker are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

**COUNT 4: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED
CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**

Commencing on or about the 16th day of January 2011, A.D., through the 26th day of April 2011, A.D. in Craig County, Oklahoma, Joseph Fairchild and Phillip Hawk conjointly and feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Joseph Fairchild and Philip Hawk bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Ralph Chaffin, the owner, personal property, namely a Massey Ferguson Cab Tractor with a serial number of [REDACTED], that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: Joseph Fairchild taking said Massey Ferguson Cab Tractor from 432554 E. 290 Rd., Vinita OK 73401, and delivering it to Phillip Hawk. Said acts by Joseph Fairchild and Phillip Hawk are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

**COUNT 5: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED
CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**

Commencing on or about the 16th day of January, 2011, A.D., through the 26th day of April 2011, A.D. in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, Joseph Fairchild feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Joseph Fairchild bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Cathy Connor previously known as Cathy Smith, the owner, personal property, namely a 2007 Kubota Tractor with a serial number of [REDACTED], that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: taking the said tractor and selling it to another person. Said acts by Joseph Fairchild are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

**COUNT 6: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED
CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**

Commencing on or about the 21st day of December, 2010, A.D., through the 26th day of April, 2011, A.D. in Craig and McIntosh Counties, Oklahoma, Joseph Fairchild, Coy Short conjointly and feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Joseph Fairchild bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Ricky Clayborn, the owner, personal property, namely a 2000 Hart gooseneck white horse trailer with partial serial number

[REDACTED], saddle and tack, that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: Taking the trailer, saddle and tack and delivering to Coy Short. Said acts by Joseph Fairchild and Coy Short are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 7: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT

Commencing on or about the 3rd day of April, 2009, A.D., through the 26th day of April, 2011, A.D. in McIntosh County, Oklahoma, Coy Short feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Coy Short bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Mitzi Bailey, the owner, personal property, namely a Stidham white horse trailer with a serial number of [REDACTED] that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: the trailer was taken from a stalled vehicle in the parking lot of the Flying J truck stop in Checotah Okla. and was found in the possession of Coy Short. Said acts by Coy Short are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 8: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT

Commencing on or about the 16th day of January, 2011, A.D., through the 26th day of April, 2012, A.D. in Okmulgee County, Oklahoma, Phillip Hawk feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Phillip Hawk bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Humphrey Equipment, the owner, personal property, namely a 1998 Wilson Trailer, belonging to PST or interested parties of said PST, thereof, of Columbus Nebraska, that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: transferring the stolen trailer to another person with an altered serial number and the serial number of a trailer belonging to Brian Sowels. Said acts by Phillip Hawk are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 9: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT

Commencing on or about the 8th day of January, 2011, A.D., through the 26th day of April 2011, A.D. in Washington County, Oklahoma, Joseph Fairchild and Phillip Hawk conjointly and feloniously committed the crime of **CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Joseph Fairchild and Phillip Hawk bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Susan Jackson, the owner, personal property, namely a 2004 White Sunlite Horse Trailer with a serial number of [REDACTED] that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery,

knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: taking the trailer, changing the VIN and selling it. Said acts by Joseph Fairchild and Phillip Hawk are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

**COUNT 10: CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED
CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT**

Commencing on or about the 15th day of January, 2011, A.D. and continuing through the 26th day of April, 2011, in Nowata County, Oklahoma, Joseph Fairchild and Phillip Hawk conjointly and feloniously committed the crime of CONCEALING OR RECEIVING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT. During the times set forth herein, and within said County and State, Joseph Fairchild and Phillip Hawk bought, received, concealed, withheld, aided in concealing or withholding from Eldon Lunsford, the owner, personal property, namely a 2006 Sundowner stock trailer with a serial number of [REDACTED] that had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery, knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that said property had been stolen, embezzled, obtained by false pretense or robbery specifically by: Joseph Fairchild taking the trailers and selling it to Phillip Hawk for a price which said Hawk would have reasonably known said property had been stolen. Said acts by Joseph Fairchild and Phillip Hawk are contrary to the provisions of section 1713.1 of title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

**COUNT 11: OBTAINING MONEY, PROPERTY OR THING OF VALUE BY FALSE
PRETENSE**

Commencing on the 1st day of March 2008, and through the 31st day of March, 2008 in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, Joseph E. Fairchild and Stevie Starks, conjointly and, with the intent to cheat and defraud, obtained or attempted to obtain from any person, firm or corporation any money, property or valuable thing, of a value more than \$1000.00, by means or by use of any trick or deception, or false or fraudulent representation or statement or pretense, or by any other means or instruments or device commonly called the "confidence game", or by means or use of any false or bogus checks, or by any other written or printed or engrave instrument or spurious coin, , specifically by taking a written instrument ,a check, given to him for the purchase of cattle by Cathy (Smith) Connor and cashing the check by listing Stevie Starks as the payee and Stevie Starks receiving payment for endorsing it and converting the money for their own use, while telling Cathy Connor that he had purchased cattle when, in fact, he had not, contrary to the provisions of Section 1541.1 and 1541.2 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

**COUNT 12: POSSESSION OF A STOLEN OR CONVERTED VEHICLE OR
IMPLEMENT OF HUSBANDRY**

Commencing on the 16th day of February, 2011, in McIntosh County Coy Leroy Short who received, possessed, concealed, sold or disposed of a vehicle or implement of husbandry, specifically a John Deere 4430 Cab Tractor, knowing the vehicle or implement of husbandry to be stolen or converted under circumstances constituting a crime specifically by: purchasing a tractor with the serial number removed at a price far below its commercial value contrary to the

provisions of Section 4-103 of Title 47 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 13: POSSESSION OF A VEHICLE WITHOUT A VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Commencing on the 16th of February, 2011, in McIntosh County Coy Leroy Short who buys, disposes, sells, transfers, or possesses a motor vehicle or motor vehicle part, with the knowledge that the vehicle identification number of the motor vehicle or motor vehicle part has been altered, counterfeited, defaced, destroyed, disguised, falsified, forged, obliterated, or removed specifically by: having possession and control of a John Deere 4430 Cab Tractor with the public vehicle identification number (VIN) number removed contrary to the provisions of Section 1503 (C) of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 14: CONSPIRACY TO VIOLATE THE CRIME OF RECEIVING OR CONCEALING STOLEN FARM EQUIPMENT

Commencing on or about the 31st day of July, 2007, A.D., through the 26th day April, 2011, A.D. in various counties located throughout Oklahoma including but not limited to Washington, Osage, Nowata, Craig, Lincoln, McIntosh, Oklahoma and Sequoyah Counties, Oklahoma, Phillip Howard Hawk, Coy Leroy Short, Kory Pierson, Stevie Starks, and George Baker individually and together with other persons, knowingly and feloniously agreed to violate the crimes of Receiving or Concealing Stolen Farm Equipment to-wit: Phillip Hawk d/b/a PH Hawk Trucking was engaged in the business of commercially moving slaughter horses, cattle, hay and farm equipment around the United States and to Mexico. As a part of his business he has Fairchild in the receipt of two stolen tractors belonging to Ralph Chafin of Craig County and

another belonging to Robert Hughes of Osage County. The Robert Hughes tractor was found on property adjoining Stevie Starks land in McIntosh County by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Agents. Stevie Starks is an associate of Phillip Hawk and receives or delivers equipment to and from Phillip Hawk. Stevie Starks also, endorsed a check for Joseph Fairchild. Joseph Fairchild also was an associate of Coy Leroy Short and delivered to Coy Short in McIntosh County a stolen trailer belonging to Ricky Don Clayborn. George Baker is also a person who had done horse business with Phillip Hawk. Three stolen four wheeler all-terrain vehicles were found on George Baker's property in Lincoln County. One came from Phillip Hawk. The another all-terrain vehicle belonging to Shep's Yamaha in Washington County was delivered to George Baker by Kory Pierson. Kory Pierson has a trailer repair business in Lincoln County that had done business with Phillip Hawk. Kory Pierson was found in possession of vehicle identification number plates and a vehicle identification stamping kit. Kory Pierson tried to assist Phillip Hawk get his truck and trailer out of impound at the Osage County Sheriff's Office. Contrary to the provisions of Section 421 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 15: RACKETEERING

Commencing on or about the 31st day of July, 2007, A.D., through the 26th day of April, 2011, A.D. in various counties located throughout Oklahoma including but not limited to Washington, Osage, Nowata, Craig, Lincoln, McIntosh, Oklahoma and Sequoyah Counties, Oklahoma, Phillip Howard Hawk, Coy Leroy Short, Kory Pierson, Stevie Starks, and George Baker individually and together with other persons, knowingly and feloniously committed the crime of RACKETEERING, to-wit:


1. Phillip Hawk stole a tractor belonging to Robert Hughes in Osage County and Phillip Hawk has a business known as P.H. Hawk Trucking that hauls, horses, cattle, hay, and farm equipment in the United States and to Mexico. Phillip Hawk is in the delivery of horses to Mexico for slaughter.
2. Phillip Hawk was in possession of a Honda Rancher Four Wheeler that was taken from Lance Berglan and delivered the said Four Wheeler to George Baker. George Baker is engaged in selling horses for the horse slaughter business.
3. Phillip Hawk was arrested in Texas while pulling a 1998 Wilson stolen trailer from PSI, a business in Nebraska, said trailer was attached with a Vehicle Identification Number of a 1994 Wilson trailer that showed being registered to Phillip Hawk.
4. Phillip Hawk sold a 2004 Sundowner trailer to German Sosa-Villegas that was stolen by Joseph Fairchild from Susan Jackson.
5. Phillip Hawk bought a 2006 Sundowner aluminum stolen stock trailer from Joseph Fairchild which Phillip Hawk was taking to Old Mexico for sale. It was bought for \$1,500.00 and the owner Eldon Lunsford valued at \$21,000.00.
6. Phillip Hawk received a stolen tractor from Joseph Fairchild that was taken from Ralph Chafin, being a 2003 Massey Ferguson tractor.
7. George Baker was found in possession of a stolen all-terrain vehicle, namely a Honda Rancher Four-wheeler. Said vehicle was stolen from Lance Berglan. Lance Berglan's stolen all-terrain vehicle was received from Phillip Hawk.
8. George Baker was found in possession of a stolen all-terrain vehicle, namely a Kawasaki 600 Mule belonging to Shep's Yamaha. George Baker said he received it from a deceased friend named "Stevie". It was delivered by Kory Pierson to the Baker residence.

9. George Baker was found in possession of a stolen all-terrain vehicle, namely a Kubota RTV 900 belonging to a Harold Rogers. It was delivered to Kory Pierson to the Baker Residence.
10. Stevie Starks was in possession a tractor belonging to Robert Hughes that Phillip Hawk had stolen from Osage County. Stevie Starks is involved in construction business and receives and/or delivers equipment to or from Phillip Hawk.
11. Stevie Starks endorsed a check from Cathy (Smith) Connors made payable to him for the alleged purchase of cattle by Joe Fairchild. Stevie Starks received approximately five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for his endorsement.
12. Coy Leroy Short sold a horse trailer that was owned by Ricky Clayborn to Randall Whisenhunt that came from Joseph Fairchild.
13. Coy Leroy Short was in possession of a stolen horse trailer that belonged to Mitzi Bailey.
14. Coy Leroy Short was in possession of a John Deere Tractor without the public vehicle identification number.

Said acts by Phillip Howard Hawk, Coy Leroy Short, Kory Pierson, Stevie Starks, and George Baker are contrary to the provisions of Section 1403 of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Penalties:

CONCEALING STOLEN OR EMBEZZLED CONSTRUCTION OR FARM EQUIPMENT in violation of 21 O.S. § 1713.1.1 [Counts 1 through 10] : Shall be a felony punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not more than ten (10) years and a fine of an amount that is equal to three times the value of the property that was stolen but not more than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) or by both such fine and imprisonment.

OBTAINING MONEY, PROPERTY OR THING OF VALUE BY FALSE PRETENSE in violation of 21 O.S. § 1541.1 & 1541.2 [Count 15]: Shall be a felony punishable by imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not more than ten (10) years or by a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

POSSESSION OF A STOLEN OR CONVERTED VEHICLE OR IMPLEMENT OF HUSBANDRY in violation of 47 O.S. § 4-103 [Count 16]: Shall be a felony and shall be punishable by imprisonment for not less than one (1) year or more than five (5) years, or by a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

POSSESSION OF A VEHICLE WITHOUT A VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER in violation of 47 O.S. § 1503 (C) [Count 17] : Shall be a felony and shall be punishable by imprisonment for not more than five (5) years, or by a fine of not more than (\$50,00.00), or by both such imprisonment and fine.

CONSPIRACY TO VIOLATE THE CRIME OF RECEIVING OR CONCEALING STOLEN FARM EQUIPMENT in violation of 21 O.S. § 421 [Count 16]: Shall be a felony and shall be punishable by a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for not more than ten (10) years or a fine of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or by both such fine and imprisonment.

RACKETEERING in violation of 22 O.S. § 1403 [Count 18]: Shall be a felony and shall be punished by a term of imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for a term of not less than (10) years.
