ORDER

NOW on this 25 day of May, 2011, the Court having been presented, in open court, an indictment returned by the Oklahoma Multicounty Grand Jury, the Court finds and orders as follows:

1. Said indictment having been examined by the Court, the Court pursuant to the provisions of 22 O.S. Section 358 finds and orders that venue and jurisdiction shall be in Pittsburg County, State of Oklahoma;

2. That said indictment shall be transmitted by the Attorney General or one of his Assistant Attorneys General to the District Court Clerk of Pittsburg County who, thereafter, upon receipt thereof shall notify the District Judge of Pittsburg County of the filing of the same;

3. That the District Judge of Pittsburg County shall proceed according to the provisions of Title 22 O.S. Section 386;

4. That said indictment may be unsealed by the District Judge of Pittsburg County for the purpose of issuing arrest warrants, and thereafter shall remain sealed under the Order of the District Court of Pittsburg County until such time following the arrest and arraignment of the named accused.

EMBEZZLEMENT OF PROPERTY EXCEEDING VALUE OF \$500.00,
21 O.S. Supp. 2004, § 1451(A) [1 Count, being Count 2]
STEALING AND/OR DESTROYING OR SECRETING A PUBLIC BOOK OR
RECORD, 21 O.S. 2001, § 461 [6 Counts, being Counts 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8]

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Thirteenth Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from February 22, 2011 until August 22, 2012 or until the designated presiding judge determines the Thirteenth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That the said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and woman, legally drawn and summons according to law and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn and charged according to law to diligently inquire into and true presentment make of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find that:

COUNT 1: EMBEZZLEMENT OF PUBLIC MONEY

During a time period between the 1st day of July, 2009 and the 17th day of May, 2010, A.D., the crime of **Embezzlement of Public Money** was committed in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma by the defendant, **ANGELA MARIE MARCUM, a.k.a., ANGELA MARIE TARRON**. That is to say that on the said date and within the aforesaid County and State, the said Defendant was the Drug Court Coordinator for the District 18 Drug Court Program serving Pittsburg County and McIntosh County, Oklahoma; that the Defendant as Drug Court Coordinator was entrusted with the collection of fees paid by participants of the Drug Court Program and with the depositing of said fees with the County Treasurer for Pittsburg County, Oklahoma; that the Defendant, on numerous occasions during said time period, was entrusted with the receipt of thousands of dollars of fees paid by District 18 Drug Court participants, including, but not limited to the following:

EUGENE TILLMAN, III – Four Thousand, Two Hundred Dollars (\$4,200.00) currency of the United States, paid on or about January 29, 2010;

TRESA PIPPIN – Two Thousand, Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$2,950.00) currency of the United States, paid on or about February 2, 2010;

GINCY HEDGECOCK Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) currency of the United States, paid on or about February 4, 2010;

JASON COX – Two Thousand, Four Hundred Dollars (\$2,400.00) currency of the United States, paid on or about February 5, 2010;

CARA HAFEMANN – Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) currency of the United States, paid on or about February 8, 2010;

WACEY NOWLIN – \$1,400.00 currency of the United States, paid on or about April 7, 2010;

that all of the foregoing fees so collected by the Defendant from the individuals named above, together with more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) in fees collected from other District 18 Drug Court Program participants; that all of said fees when collected were appropriated by law to the use and benefit of the said District 18 Drug Court Program, that such funds so collected by Defendant were never deposited to the credit of the District 18 Drug Court Program, but instead the Defendant willfully, intentionally, fraudulently and feloniously misappropriated and converted said monies to a use contrary to and not in accordance with the trust imposed in her regarding such funds by the District 18 Drug Court Program, all in violation of Section 1451(C) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 2: EMBEZZLEMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY

On or about the 17th day of May, 2010, A.D., the crime of **Embezzlement of Public Property** was committed in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma by the defendant, **ANGELA MARIE MARCUM, a.k.a., ANGELA MARIE TARRON**. That is to say that on the said date and within the aforesaid County and State, the said Defendant was the Drug Court Coordinator for the District 18 Drug Court Program serving Pittsburg County and McIntosh County, Oklahoma; that the Defendant as Drug Court Coordinator was entrusted with the possession and use of a certain laptop computer, *to-wit*: a black in color Hewlett-Packard laptop computer, loaded with business accounting software used for keeping track of District 18 Drug Court Program participant fee payments; said computer and software being of a value greater than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00); that on or about the aforesaid date and within said County and State, Defendant willfully, intentionally, fraudulently and feloniously misappropriated and converted said monies to a use contrary to and not in accordance with the trust imposed in her regarding such property owned by the District 18 Drug Court Program, all in violation of Section 1451(A) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma

Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 3: STEALING AND DESTROYING AND/OR SECRETING A PUBLIC BOOK OR RECORD

On a date presently unknown, but occurring between the 9th day of October, 2009 and the 12th day of May, 2010, A.D., the crime of **Stealing or Secreting Public Records** was committed in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma by the defendant, by the defendant, **ANGELA MARIE MARCUM, a.k.a., ANGELA MARIE TARRON**. That is to say that on the said date and within the aforesaid County and State, the said Defendant was the Drug Court Coordinator for the District 18 Drug Court Program serving Pittsburg County and McIntosh County, Oklahoma; that the Defendant as Drug Court Coordinator was entrusted with the possession and custody of an official receipt book for recording payments made by participants in the District 18 Drug Court Program, said receipt book being a book and public record filed and kept in the office of the District 18 Drug Court Program, said receipt book containing copies of sequentially numbered receipts numbered **2951 to 3000** inclusive; that the Defendant did then and there, willfully and feloniously take, carry away, and steal and thereafter did destroy or secrete said receipt book, all in violation of Section 1451(A) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 4: STEALING AND DESTROYING AND/OR SECRETING A PUBLIC BOOK OR RECORD

On a date presently unknown, but occurring between the 3rd day of August, 2009 and the 12th day of May, 2010, A.D., the crime of **Stealing or Secreting Public Records** was committed in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma by the defendant, by the defendant, **ANGELA MARIE MARCUM, a.k.a., ANGELA MARIE TARRON**. That is to say that on the said date and within the aforesaid County and State, the said Defendant was the Drug Court Coordinator for the District 18 Drug Court Program serving Pittsburg County and McIntosh County, Oklahoma; that the Defendant as Drug

Court Coordinator was entrusted with the possession and custody of an official receipt book for recording payments made by participants in the District 18 Drug Court Program, said receipt book being a book and public record filed and kept in the office of the District 18 Drug Court Program, said receipt book containing copies of sequentially numbered receipts numbered 3401 to 3450 inclusive; that the Defendant did then and there, willfully and feloniously take, carry away, and steal and thereafter did destroy or secrete said receipt book, all in violation of Section 1451(A) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 5: STEALING AND DESTROYING AND/OR SECRETING A PUBLIC BOOK OR RECORD

On a date presently unknown, but occurring between November 2009 and the 12th day of May, 2010, A.D., the crime of **Stealing or Secreting Public Records** was committed in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma by the defendant, by the defendant, **ANGELA MARIE MARCUM, a.k.a., ANGELA MARIE TARRON**. COUNT 6: STEALING AND DESTROYING AND/OR SECRETING A PUBLIC BOOK OR RECORD

On a date presently unknown, but occurring between November 2009 and the 12th day of May, 2010, A.D., the crime of **Stealing or Secreting Public Records** was committed in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma by the defendant, by the defendant, **ANGELA MARIE MARCUM, a.k.a., ANGELA MARIE TARRON**. COUNT 7: STEALING AND DESTROYING AND/OR SECRETING A PUBLIC BOOK OR RECORD

On a date presently unknown, but occurring between November 2009 and the 12th day of May, 2010, A.D., the crime of **Stealing or Secreting Public Records** was committed in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma by the defendant, by the defendant, **ANGELA MARIE MARCUM, a.k.a., ANGELA MARIE TARRON**. That is to say that on the said date and within the aforesaid County and State, the said Defendant was the Drug Court Coordinator for the District 18 Drug Court Program serving Pittsburg County and McIntosh County, Oklahoma; that the Defendant as Drug Court Coordinator was entrusted with the possession and custody of an official receipt book for

recording payments made by participants in the District 18 Drug Court Program, said receipt book being a book and public record filed and kept in the office of the District 18 Drug Court Program, said receipt book containing copies of sequentially numbered receipts numbered 3601 to 3650 inclusive; that the Defendant did then and there, willfully and feloniously take, carry away, and steal and thereafter did destroy or secrete said receipt book, all in violation of Section 1451(A) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 8: STEALING AND DESTROYING AND/OR SECRETING A PUBLIC BOOK OR RECORD

On a date presently unknown, but occurring between June 2009 and the 12th day of May, 2010, A.D., the crime of **Stealing or Secreting Public Records** was committed in Pittsburg County, Oklahoma by the defendant, by the defendant, **ANGELA MARIE MARCUM, a.k.a., ANGELA MARIE TARRON**. That is to say that on the said date and within the aforesaid County and State, the said Defendant was the Drug Court Coordinator for the District 18 Drug Court Program serving Pittsburg County and McIntosh County, Oklahoma; that the Defendant as Drug Court Coordinator was entrusted with the possession and custody of an official receipt book for recording payments made by participants in the District 18 Drug Court Program, said receipt book being a book and public record filed and kept in the office of the District 18 Drug Court Program, said receipt book containing copies of sequentially numbered receipts numbered 3651 to 3700 inclusive; that the Defendant did then and there, willfully and feloniously take, carry away, and steal and thereafter did destroy or secrete said receipt book, all in violation of Section 1451(A) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

Penalties:

Embezzlement of Public Money, 21 O.S. Supp. 2004, § 1451(C). Imprisonment in the State Penitentiary for not less than one (1) year, nor more than ten (10) years imprisonment and a fine equal to three (3) times the amount of money embezzled.

Embezzlement of Public Property, 21 O.S. Supp. 2004, § 1451(A) & (B)(1). Imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than one (1) year and a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

STEALING [etc.] A PUBLIC BOOK OR RECORD, Imprisonment in the State Penitentiary not to exceed five (5) years and forfeiture of office.
