INDICTMENT

FOR: MAKING A FALSE, FICTITIOUS, OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM, 21 O.S. § 358
[7 Counts being Counts 1 through 7]

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Fourteenth Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from February 25, 2013 until August 25, 2014, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Fourteenth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That the said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and women, legally drawn and summoned according to law, and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn and charged according to law to diligently inquire into and true presentment make of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find that:

COUNT 1: MAKING A FALSE FICTITIOUS OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM.

On or about the 27th day of September 2010, by presenting to Mayor Jerry Shinn, an employee or officer of the State of Oklahoma or department or agency thereof, a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim for payment of public funds against the State of Oklahoma, to-wit: on said date defendant filed Employee Time Sheets signed by him avowing that he was on duty in the City of Idabel on Idabel on the 2nd day of September 2010, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Hugo, Oklahoma) and on the 6th and 23rd days of September 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Broken Bow, Oklahoma). All of said acts being contrary to the provisions of Section 358 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 2: MAKING A FALSE FICTITIOUS OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM.

On or about the 22nd day of November 2010, by presenting to Mayor Jerry Shinn, an employee or officer of the State of Oklahoma or department or agency thereof, a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim for payment of public funds against the State of Oklahoma, to-wit: on said date defendant filed Employee Time Sheets signed by him avowing that he was on duty in the City of Idabel on the 25th day of October 2010, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Broken Bow, Oklahoma). All of said acts being contrary to the provisions of Section 358 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 3: MAKING A FALSE FICTITIOUS OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM.

On or about the 26th day of September 2011, by presenting to Mayor Tina Foshee-Thomas, an employee or officer of the State of Oklahoma or department or agency thereof, a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim for payment of public funds against the State of Oklahoma, to-wit: on said date defendant filed Employee Time Sheets signed by him avowing that he was on duty in the City of Idabel on the 2nd day of September 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Atoka, Oklahoma) and on the 22nd day of September 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Broken Bow, Oklahoma). All of said acts being contrary to the provisions of Section 358 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 4: MAKING A FALSE FICTITIOUS OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM.

On or about the 24th day of October 2011, by presenting to Mayor Tina Foshee-Thomas, an employee or officer of the State of Oklahoma or department or agency thereof, a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim for payment of public funds against the State of Oklahoma, to-wit: on said date defendant filed Employee Time Sheets signed by him avowing that he was on duty in the City of Idabel on the 29th day of September 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Broken Bow, Oklahoma) and on the 11th day of October 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Broken Bow,

Oklahoma) and on the 24th day of October 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Holly Creek, Oklahoma). All of said acts being contrary to the provisions of Section 358 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 5: MAKING A FALSE FICTITIOUS OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM.

On or about the 21st day of November 2011, by presenting to Mayor Tina Foshee-Thomas, an employee or officer of the State of Oklahoma or department or agency thereof, a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim for payment of public funds against the State of Oklahoma, to-wit: on said date defendant filed Employee Time Sheets signed by him avowing that he was on duty in the City of Idabel on the 25th day of October 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Broken Bow, Oklahoma) and on the 11th and 17th days of November 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on those dates at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Forest Grove, Oklahoma). All of said acts being contrary to the provisions of Section 358 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 6: MAKING A FALSE FICTITIOUS OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM.

On or about the 19th day of December 2011, by presenting to Mayor Tina Foshee-Thomas, an employee or officer of the State of Oklahoma or department or agency thereof, a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim for payment of public funds against the State of Oklahoma, to-wit: on said date defendant filed Employee Time Sheets signed by

him avowing that he was on duty in the City of Idabel on the 1st day of December 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Forest Grove, Oklahoma) and on the 3rd and 9th days of December 2011, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on those dates at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Haworth, Oklahoma). All of said acts being contrary to the provisions of Section 358 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT 7: MAKING A FALSE FICTITIOUS OR FRAUDULENT CLAIM.

On or about the 13th day of February 2012, by presenting to Mayor Tina Foshee-Thomas, an employee or officer of the State of Oklahoma or department or agency thereof, a false, fictitious, or fraudulent claim for payment of public funds against the State of Oklahoma, to-wit: on said date defendant filed Employee Time Sheets signed by him avowing that he was on duty in the City of Idabel on the 26th day of January 2012, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Broken Bow, Oklahoma), and on the 6th day of February 2012, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on that date at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Kingston, Oklahoma) and on the 9th and 12th days of February 2012, when he was in fact working as an elementary or secondary school sports official on those dates at a location outside of the City of Idabel (to-wit: Haworth, Oklahoma). All of said acts being contrary to the provisions of Section 358 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
