

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

COMES NOW the duly elected, qualified and acting District Attorney for District 4 in and for Woodward County, State of Oklahoma, Hollis E. Thorp, by and through the assistance of W.A. Drew Edmondson, the duly elected, qualified and acting Attorney General in and for the State of Oklahoma, and gives the District Court of Woodward County, State of Oklahoma, to know and be informed that the crimes of **Filing False Fictitious or Fraudulent Claims Against the State or *In the Alternative* Obtaining or Attempting to Obtain Property by Trick or Deception-False Statements or Pretenses and Embezzlement** was feloniously committed in Woodward County, Oklahoma, in the manner and form as follows, to-wit:

Count 1:

On or about the 1st day of July, 2003 A.D., through the 31st day of July 2003 A.D., **LESLIE MORTON** while in Woodward County, Oklahoma did make, present, or cause to be presented to

an employee or officer of **WOODWARD COUNTY**, State of Oklahoma, or to a department or agency thereof, a false, fictitious or fraudulent claim(s) for payment of public funds upon or against **WOODWARD COUNTY**, State of Oklahoma, or a department thereof, knowing such claim to be false, fictitious or fraudulent and contrary to the provisions of *title 21* of the Oklahoma Statutes Section 358 and that **LESLIE MORTON** did in fact receive a benefit as a direct result of having made said false, fictitious or fraudulent claim(s) for payment. That **LESLIE MORTON** submitted said false, fictitious or fraudulent claim(s) while knowingly and willfully omitting the performance of an official act and/or duty in relation thereto and/or submitted the referenced claim(s) so as to fraudulently collect a travel allowance intended by law to only be issued in lieu of reimbursement for travel expenses within **WOODWARD COUNTY**. That **LESLIE MORTON**'s intentional submission of false, fictitious or fraudulent claim(s) directly resulted in the preparation and release of a warrant issued by and through the clerk's office in and for **WOODWARD COUNTY** and, therefore, resulted in financial loss to **WOODWARD COUNTY** and personal financial gain to and for **LESLIE MORTON** contrary to law and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

That **LESLIE MORTON** submitted said false, fictitious or fraudulent claim(s) while knowingly and willfully omitting the performance of an official act and/or duty in relation thereto and/or submitted the referenced claim(s) so as to fraudulently collect a travel allowance intended by law to only be issued in lieu of reimbursement for travel expenses within **WOODWARD COUNTY**. That is to say **LESLIE MORTON** did knowingly, willfully, fraudulently and feloniously divert to is own use said 2006 Dodge Charger and said fuelman credit card assigned to said Sheriff's department and thereby obtained for his personal use the said county issued vehicle and fuel valued at forty six dollars and eighty-two cents (\$ 46.82) good and lawful money of the United States of America, by charging gasoline in order to fuel the county vehicle while defendant was engaged in personal business outside and beyond the boundaries of Woodward County and while the defendant was not otherwise engaged in business relating to the County of Woodward the defendant used the said county vehicle and fuelman credit card issued and entrusted as aforesaid as follows:

by charging 17.367 gallons of gasoline from a fuelman automated site located at 550 South Welbaum Road Calumet, Oklahoma at \$46.82 on Thursday November 15, 2007 at 4:30 p.m.;

all of said use being unauthorized and said charges being thereafter paid in full with funds belonging to the County of Woodward that had been appropriated for the aforesaid different, official use; all of said acts being committed contrary to the provisions of Section 1451 (C) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
