## Rules

Entries and completed entry forms must be received by close of business Jan. 4, 2010. Entries received after this date will not be considered. Nominated activity must have occurred within calendar year 2009. All nominations must relate to the protection of Oklahoma consumers. All nominations must be submitted on an official nomination form. Incomplete nomination forms will not be considered. Nominations can be made by or on behalf of the nominee. Only individuals are eligible for the award. Companies and government agencies are not eligible, but individual employees may be nominated. Attorney General investigators will conduct a criminal history background check before a winner is announced. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The winner will be notified in writing and is requested to attend a presentation ceremony to be held Feb. 4 in Oklahoma City. Information collected in the nomination forms will be used only for evaluation purposes, although some information will be made public to promote the competition and recognize the winner. In accepting the award, the winner agrees to allow photographs and necessary personal information to be made public in announcing the winner. Nomination forms will not be returned. All information received and developed in conjunction with this competition remains the property of the Office of the Attorney General.
