ORDER SETTING EXECUTION DATE

On January 9, 2012, the State, through Oklahoma Attorney General E. Scott Pruitt and Assistant Attorney General Seth S. Branham, notified this Court that Appellant, Timothy Shaun Stemple, has exhausted all State and Federal appeals of his first degree murder conviction and death sentence in Tulsa County District Court Case No. CF-1996-5169.¹ The State notes that his last appeal was denied by the United States Supreme Court on January 9, 2012.

The State requests that an execution date be set, pursuant to 22 O.S.Supp.2004, § 1001.1. We find that the State's application is proper.

Apr. 4, 2011) (unpublished), *cert. denied*, ___ U.S. ___, ___ S.Ct. ___, 2012 WL 33499 (January 9, 2012). Stemple was also convicted of conspiracy to commit first degree murder and was sentenced to 10 years imprisonment; Stemple's conviction for attempted first degree murder was dismissed on direct appeal.

Therefore, we hereby order the execution of the judgment and sentence of death be carried out. The execution date of Timothy Shaun Stemple shall be set for Thursday, March 15, 2012.


