INFORMATION

W.A. DREW EDMONDSON, the duly elected, qualified and acting Attorney General of the State of Oklahoma, and gives the District Court of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to know and be informed that Mary San Juanita Porras did in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma on or about the dates as set forth below commit the crime of **Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance**, in the manner and form as follows, to wit:

**Count 1: Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance, a Felony
Title 63 O.S. § 2-403(A)**

On or about August 22, 2009, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Mary San Juanita Porras committed the crime of **Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance, a felony**, in violation of Title 63 O.S. § 2-403(A), by taking and carrying away by stealth 30 doses of Hydrocodone APAP 5/500, a drug that is classified as controlled dangerous substances under the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of Oklahoma and belonging to Delsie Stembridge, a resident of Maplewood Care Center, without the consent and with intent to deprive the resident of the drugs permanently.

Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance is punishable by imprisonment for up to ten (10) years.

**Count 2: Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance, a Felony
Title 63 O.S. § 2-403(A)**

On or about August 22, 2009, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Mary San Juanita Porras committed the crime of **Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance, a felony**, in violation of Title 63 O.S. § 2-403(A), by taking and carrying away by stealth 15 doses of Lorazepam 0.5 mg, a drug that is classified as controlled dangerous substances under the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of Oklahoma and belonging to Adal Bowen, a resident of Maplewood Care

Center, without the consent and with intent to deprive the resident of the drugs permanently.

Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance is punishable by imprisonment for up to ten (10) years.

**Count 3: Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance, a Felony
Title 63 O.S. § 2-403(A)**

On or about August 22, 2009, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Mary San Juanita Porras committed the crime of **Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance, a felony**, in violation of Title 63 O.S. § 2-403(A), by taking and carrying away by stealth seven doses of Zolpiden 5 mg, a drug that is classified as controlled dangerous substances under the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of Oklahoma and belonging to Gabriele Gabrielle, a resident of Maplewood Care Center, without the consent and with intent to deprive the resident of the drugs permanently.

Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance is punishable by imprisonment for up to ten (10) years.

**Count 4: Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance, a Felony
Title 63 O.S. § 2-403(A)**

On or about August 22, 2009, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, Mary San Juanita Porras committed the crime of **Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance, a felony**, in violation of Title 63 O.S. § 2-403(A), by taking and carrying away by stealth 30 doses of Lorazepam 0.5 mg, a drug that is classified as controlled dangerous substances under the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act of Oklahoma and belonging to Anice Roland, a resident of Maplewood Care Center, without the consent and with intent to deprive the resident of the drugs permanently.

Larceny of Controlled Dangerous Substance is punishable by imprisonment for up to ten (10) years.

All in violation of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
