IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Thirteenth Multicounty Grand Jury was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from February 22, 2011 until August 22, 2012 or until the designated presiding judge determines the Thirteenth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That the said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and woman, legally drawn and summons according to law and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn and charged according to law to diligently inquire into and true presentment make of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find that:

COUNT 1: ASKING FOR A GRATUITY FOR PERFORMING AN OFFICIAL ACT

On or about the 28th day of May, 2012, A.D., the crime of **Asking for a Gratuity for Performing an Official Act** was committed in Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, by the defendant,

PATRICIA MIGLIACCIO. That is to say that on or about said date and within said County and State, the Defendant was employed as an Investigator for the Cosmetology Board, an agency of the State of Oklahoma and as such was an executive officer of the State of Oklahoma. That on or about the said date and within said County and State, the defendant did willfully, intentionally, and unlawfully ask for a gratuity from Tina Vo, a person seeking an oral examination for a license to be issued by the Cosmetology Board, with the assurance to Vo that Vo would pass the exam by being provided the correct answers in the course of Vo taking the test; all of the foregoing being committed in violation of Section 269(A) of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the Peace and Dignity of the State of Oklahoma.
