IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

By the order of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma, the Twentieth Multicounty Grand Jury of Oklahoma was convened with its principal site to be in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma, to serve from June 27, 2023, for eighteen (18) months, or until the designated presiding judge determines the Twentieth Multicounty Grand Jury has reached reasonable completion of its investigations, but, in any event, no more than twenty-four (24) months from the commencement of its term. That said Multicounty Grand Jury of the State of Oklahoma, being composed of good and lawful men and women, legally drawn and summoned according to law, and then and there examined, impaneled, sworn, and charged according to law to diligently inquire into, and true presentment make, of all public offenses against the State of Oklahoma committed and triable within the State of Oklahoma, upon their oath, and in the name and by the authority of the State of Oklahoma, do present and find:

COUNT 1: CONSPIRACY AGAINST THE STATE, 21 O.S. § 424, a FELONY

On, or about, or between December 30, 2019 and November 22, 2022, the crime of CONSPIRACY AGAINST THE STATE was committed by **KEVIN PAUL PHAM, ALEX SHIANG LIN CHANG,** and **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO** who, acting conjointly together and with others, willfully and feloniously conspired to defraud the State of Oklahoma by knowingly providing fraudulent documentation and information to Oklahoma state agencies for the purpose of obtaining licensing and registration through the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority and Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, and in furtherance thereof did commit one or more of the following overt acts:

RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO provided his driver's license to **KEVIN PAUL PHAM** for the purpose of submitting medical marijuana grow license applications containing false information to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and/or the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority;

KEVIN PAUL PHAM did then repeatedly provide payment to **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO,** which the latter did accept, in exchange for agreeing to provide false information to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs and/or the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority during the course of the conspiracy;

KEVIN PAUL PHAM and **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO** entered into a consulting agreement regarding Valerie Farm Inc., a marijuana grow facility. Following the execution of said agreement, **KEVIN PAUL PHAM** submitted or caused to be submitted an application or other

document claiming that **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO** was a legitimate majority owner of Valerie Farm Inc. to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs and/or the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.

KEVIN PAUL PHAM and **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO** entered into a consulting agreement regarding Aladdin Farms Inc., a marijuana grow facility. Following the execution of said agreement, **KEVIN PAUL PHAM** submitted or caused to be submitted an application or other document claiming that **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO** was a legitimate majority owner of Valerie Farms Inc. to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs and/or the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.

ALEX SHIANG LIN CHANG facilitated the introduction of **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO** and **KEVIN PAUL PHAM** for the purpose of involving **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO** in the ongoing conspiracy to submit applications or other documents claiming fraudulent ownership interests in marijuana grow facilities to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs and/or the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.

ALEX SHIANG LIN CHANG sent a photograph of **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO**'s driver's license to **KEVIN PAUL PHAM** for the purpose of involving **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO** in the ongoing conspiracy to submit applications or other documents claiming fraudulent ownership interests in marijuana grow facilities to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs and/or the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.

ALEX SHIANG LIN CHANG did repeatedly provide **KEVIN PAUL PHAM** with the names and contact information for non-Oklahoma residents interested in owning marijuana grow facilities with the knowledge that said ownership was prohibited by law and with the knowledge that **KEVIN PAUL PHAM** was engaged in the practice of submitting applications or other documents claiming fraudulent ownership interests in marijuana grow facilities to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs and/or the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.

Contrary to the provisions of Section 424 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

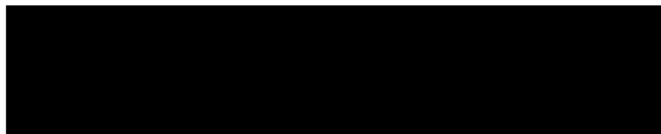

On or about July 9, 2020, September 27, 2021, September 2, 2022, and October 29, 2022, the crime of FILING A FALSE OR FORGED INSTRUMENT was committed by **KEVIN PAUL PHAM** and **RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO**, who knowingly procured or offered a false or forged instrument to be filed, registered, or recorded at the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority and the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control, both being public offices in the State of Oklahoma, as part of the application for Liu & Chen, Inc., Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority License Number GAAA-R6UL-LKFK and Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control Registration Number 3090098 or who otherwise aided, promoted, or encouraged the same by act or counsel contrary to the provisions of Section 463 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

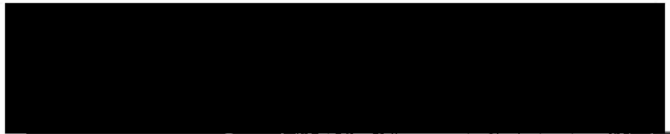

On or about November 20, 2022, the crime of AGGRAVATED MANUFACTURING OF MARIJUANA was committed by KEVIN PAUL PHAM and RICHARD GREGORIO IGNACIO, who conjointly and in concert with one another, knowingly aided, promoted, or encouraged others, both known and unknown to the Grand Jury, in the production, preparation, propagation, compounding or processing of a controlled dangerous substance, to wit: marijuana at Liu & Chen, Inc., 2372 North 2760 Rd, Hennessey, Kingfisher County, Oklahoma in the amount of one thousand (1,000) or more plants containing a detectable amount of marijuana, a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance, contrary to the provisions of Section 2-401(G) of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

- COUNT(S) 9:** Trafficking in Methamphetamine – Imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections not to exceed twenty (20) years and a fine of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00). 63 O.S. § 2-415(C)(4). 63 O.S. § 2-415(D).
- COUNT(S) 10:** Possession with Intent to Distribute Marijuana – Imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections not to exceed five (5) years and a fine not to exceed Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00). 63 O.S. § 2-401(B)(2).
- COUNT(S) 11:** Possession of Firearm After Former Conviction of a Felony – Imprisonment in the Department of Corrections for one (1) to ten (10) years. 21 O.S. § 1283(A). 21 O.S. § 1284.
- COUNT(S) 12:** Financial Transactions Involving Proceeds from Unlawful Acts – Imprisonment in the Department of Corrections of five (5) to twenty (20) years. 21 O.S. § 2001(G)(4).
