## ATTORNEY GENERAL OPINION 2018-206A

Dear Executive Director Glazier:

This office has received your request for a written Attorney General Opinion regarding action that the Oklahoma Board of Nursing intends to take in case 3.254.18. In 1990, the licensee was charged with several misdemeanors. The applicant falsified an NCLEX-LPN license application by failing to report the charges. The Board proposes to grant the application, but issue a severe reprimand and require the licensee to complete remedial education courses and pay a \$500 administrative penalty.

The Oklahoma Nursing Practice Act authorizes disciplinary action when a nurse "is guilty of deceit or material misrepresentation in procuring or attempting to procure" a license, "[i]s guilty of a felony, or any offense reasonably related to the qualifications, functions or duties of any licensee," or is "guilty of unprofessional conduct." 59 O.S.Supp.2017, § 567.8(B)(1)(a), (2), (7). The Board may reasonably believe that the proposed action is necessary to deter future violations.

It is, therefore, the official opinion of the Attorney General that the Oklahoma Board of Nursing has adequate support for the conclusion that this action advances the State's policy to protect public health, safety, and welfare by ensuring nurses meet minimum standards of professional conduct.
