RULEMAKING ACTION:

Notice of proposed PERMANENT rulemaking

PROPOSED RULES:

Subchapter 3. Batterers Intervention [AMENDED]

Subchapter 9. Technology [NEW]

SUMMARY:

The Attorney General is required to adopt and promulgate rules and standards for certification of batterers intervention programs (BIPs) in this state. These rules set forth the requirements which are necessary to provide services pursuant to 74 O.S. § 18p-1 et seq.

AUTHORITY:

Attorney General, Title 74 O.S. § 18p-1 et seq.

Business entities affected by these proposed rules are requested to provide the agency with information, in dollar amounts if possible, about the increase in the level of direct costs, indirect costs, or other costs expected to be incurred by the business entity due to compliance with the proposed rules. Business entities may submit this information in writing by the conclusion of the comment period or public hearing on March 19, 2021, at the Office of the Attorney General at the above address.
